The results and accomplishments for the past two years are:

- Enhanced and maintained the website
  - 240% increase in website traffic/engagement
  - *Resources/Events website traffic increase*
- Grow and expand social media engagement—Facebook, twitter, LinkedIn which and all increased in users
- Monthly Newsletter—increased open rate by 10%
- Annual report
